



Rules and Commitment Agreement

#### READY TO SPICE THINGS UP? Let's bring the flavor to the Chili showdown!

There is <u>no additional fee</u> to enter the Chili Cook-Off; however, all attendees planning to work at the Chili Cook-Off booth must register and pay for a BBQ ticket. Space is limited to 15 chili competitors, and a \$250 cancellation fee will be assessed after June 1, 2025.

As previously determined, all 2024 lottery winners are automatically entered into this year's competition. Should there be a cancellation, a runner-up will be chosen by lottery and notified as soon as space becomes available.

<u>PRIZES:</u> All winners for each category receive a cash prize, a category trophy, hats and aprons for the team, and an automatic entry into the 2024 competition.

- Judge's Choice: Best Chili 1st \$300 cash prize
- Judge's Choice: Best Chili 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> \$200 cash prize
- People's Choice: Best Chili \$300 cash prize
   People's Choice: Best Booth \$300 cash prize

## **VOTING/JUDGING:**

- Panel of Judges: Blind Tasting
  - o In your supply tub is a lettered-tasting cup. Fill this with chili, add a spoon, and bring to the voting tent on the tray provided **NO LATER THAN 5:00 PM**.
  - Garnishes are allowed.
  - When you arrive at the voting tent, look for the judges' trays marked with letters. Place your tasting cup next to the letter that matches the letter on your tasting cup.
- People's Choice: All attendees will be given one vote for their favorite chili & booth.
  - There will be a designated voting booth where all ballots will be filled out and submitted. Participants may only vote one time. Pre-filled ballots are not allowed.

 All voters must obtain a ballot from the voting booth. Distributing pre-filled ballots and/or offering ballots from your booth is not permitted.

#### **RULES & REGULATIONS:**

#### **BASIC RULES:**

- Chili must be prepared and cooked offsite. Spices, garnishes, etc., can be added onsite.
- Chili must be prepared from scratch with no commercial mixes.
- Since chili will be provided to judges and guests (over 1,400 attendees), you must provide 7-8 gallons of chili.
- Chili must be served in the cups provided by UCON.
- No alcohol can be served.

### **ARRIVAL & SET UP:**

- The booth locations are RANDOMLY assigned to contestants. Swapping of booth assignments is not allowed.
- Each booth will have a tub with the supplies noted in the "What We Provide" Section.
- Set-up duration is 2 hours, with the arrival time of 2:00 pm.
- **NOTE** No company vehicles or trailers are allowed for any reason.

## **WHAT WE PROVIDE:**

- Designated 10x10 Booth space
- 8 ft. table
- Sample 3 oz. plastic cups (Chili must be served in the cups provided)
- Tasting Spoons
- Napkins
- Trash receptacles
- Power outlets (shared) behind your tent

# **WHAT YOU PROVIDE:**

- 7-8 gallons of your chili, ready to serve
- Heating element for chili (i.e. crockpots) NO OPEN FLAMES
- Extension cord to connect to power
- Serving utensils
- Items to clean up your cook area
- Pop-up tents, additional tables, banners, signs etc. that will fit in a 10 x 10 space
- Items for cook site decoration (vehicles & trailers will NOT be permitted). Be creative with your booth and team and have fun!

# **ALCOHOL:**

- Absolutely no outside alcohol (liquid or otherwise) is permitted into the fairgrounds, nor can it be served at your booth. If any outside alcohol is found at your booth, your team will automatically forfeit the competition, be ineligible for future participation, and will need to immediately vacate the booth.
- Contenders can purchase drinks at the bar and consume them in the chili cook-off tents.
